MEMBERSHIP RULES FOR CHILDRENS GROUP LINK

(FORM G.L.3)

1. Members must be between the ages of 7 and 16 years.
2. A weekly subscription is to be paid by each member.
3. Foul or abusing language on the premises or at centre activities is prohibited.
4. Smoking is prohibited at all times.
5. Running and 'Horseplay' is prohibited on the premises.
6. Misuse or abuse of centres property is not allowed.
7. Misuse or abuse of any individuals property is not allowed.
8. Any wilful damage or defacement of the groups property, or that of any individual, must be paid for in full by the person(s) responsible.
9. Under no circumstances should any member be outside the main door of the centre without asking permission from a leader. If a member does leave the centre without knowledge of a leader, the group will not be held responsible.
10. If a member wishes to leave the centre early, a letter from parents or guardians must be given to a leader, otherwise that member will not be allowed to leave.
11. No fighting or abuse of any individual either on the premises, at centre activities or travelling to and from centre activities.
12. All members must show respect for all citizens and property when travelling to and from centre activities.
13. Members should go home immediately after centre activities.
14. All members must partake in centre activities and programmes.
15. If a member is consistently absent from the centre without an apology, he / she will be crossed off the roll.
